The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed a review of the request for renewal of the Permit to Operate the Jackson County Scott Creek including the revised *Operations Plan* (DIN 18219). The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on January 8, 2013.

The submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application.
