Please be reminded that Solid Waste Permit No. 5003T-TRANSFER- expires on August 9, 2013. Solid Waste Permits are valid for five (5) years. Renewal of an existing Solid Waste Permit must be requested and accompanied by a complete application submitted in accordance with North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-294 and must meet the requirements of North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B. Your permit renewal application must be received by the Solid Waste Section no later than February 9, 2013.
