Pursuant to Rule .0536(a)(1), the Division hereby notifies Green Recycling Solutions, LLC, that based on review of the above referenced documents, portions of the approximately 43.5-acre site are suitable for development as a solid waste unit under the conditions established in this letter and as described in the Site Study Reports and associated submittals.

With this notice, Green Recycling Solutions, LLC, is hereby authorized to prepare an application for a Permit to Construct in accordance with Rule .0535(a).

Also, please be aware that this notice is neither a permit nor a permitting decision. This notice complies with Solid Waste Management Rule .0536(a) that requires the Division to inform the applicant whether the applicant may proceed with a permit application.

Solid Waste Management Rule .0201 requires the Division to issue a solid waste permit in two parts. The first part is a Permit to Construct and the second part is a Permit to Operate. The final action the Division may take on a permit application is the issuance or denial of a permit.
