Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

1. The last notification was submitted on August 2, 2012 and is current.
2. Keep the grinding, storage and processing area below 2 acres in size.
3. No more than 6000 cubic yards of waste can be transported processed and stored on the site per quarter.
4. Any material remaining from the grinding operation that cannot be reused must be removed and transported to a facility permitted to receive this type of waste.
5. There is unprocessed woody waste (pallets and shipping containers) that has been on the site long enough to begin decaying.
6. **This waste must be either removed and transported to a facility permitted to receive this type of waste or processed in some manner. Options include grinding or windrowing for composting. If the composting option is chosen, a yard waste notification must be submitted to the Division.**
7. **The options listed in item 6 need to be completed with 30 days of the receipt of this inspection report.**
