To Whom It May Concern:

This is a letter of intent regarding plans for the NC State University transfer station located at 620 Motor Pool Street, permit 92-32.

At the present time, the transfer facility is closed due to operational and equipment upgrades that have eliminated the need for a transfer facility at the University. The current collection system utilizes self contained waste trucks to direct haul to the South Wake County Landfill or the East Wake County Transfer Facility. Furthermore, the existing transfer facility will be demolished in the summer of 2009 as part of a site renovation effort.

The University will maintain a roll off disposal and recycling area at 620 Motor Pool Street. The purpose of maintaining the area is for the disposal and recycling of bulk material such as wood, metal and aggregate and convenience for campus generators of bulk waste.

The Solid Waste Section conducted a site visit of the facility on February 9, 2009 and has determined the University is no longer required to maintain and permit the facility as a transfer station. Effective March 31, 2009, the University requests cancellation of transfer station permit 92-32.
