**Determination of Completeness**

On November 26, 2012 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received your permit amendment, five-year renewal, application, entitled;

*Permit Renewal Request for Industrial Solid Waste Landfill Facility Permit No. 9401 Domtar Paper Company, LLC – Plymouth, NC.* Prepared for Domtar Paper Company, LLC. Prepared by Joyce Engineering. November 2012. DIN 17784.

The Section has performed a review of the Facility's application for a determination of completeness and determined the application is complete, in accordance North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means the application contains the required components in accordance with North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B .0500.
