- 1) July 31, 2001 letter and attachments from Mr. E.B. Grant to William Hocutt of NC DENR providing additional information regarding the northern portion (13.5 acres) of the J.S. Turner Saw Mill Structural Fill Project. This letter states that the information demonstrates the site is in compliance with the requirements of the Beneficial Use Of Coal Combustion By-Products (CCBPs).
- 2) August 9, 2000 letter from William Hocutt to Mr. E.B. Grant requesting that the initial Notification and two subsequent revisions to that notification on the Turner Saw Mill Project be combined into a single Notification. The purpose was to achieve clarity in records of starting and closing dates, volumes of CCBPs utilized and Recordation of the entire project.

Dear Mr. Grant:

The Division of Waste Management (DWM) has reviewed the information contained in your Reference (1) package. We acknowledge that this information combined with material previously submitted by your office satisfies the Notification requirements of the .1700 Rules for the northern 13.5 acres of the project. You can proceed with fill activity in the northern portion.

Your Reference (1) letter contained a request that you be allowed to utilize existing on-site soil from the northern portion of the site as cover soil for the project. This cannot be allowed as it could compromise the required two feet separation of coal ash and ground water due to the low elevation of the northern portion. The variances and concerns that have developed in relation to the southern portion of the site are continuing to receive study by DWM.


Concerning Reference (2), you are requested to communicate in writing to the attention of Bill Hocutt: the start date, an estimated date of closing for the complete project, and an estimate of the total amount of coal ash (designate amounts of fly and bottom ash) to be utilized. Please provide this by September 1, 2001.
