On June 23, 1999, I conducted a compliance inspection of the notified land clearing and inert debris landfill located on Cherry Grove Road, Caswell County, North Carolina. At the time of my inspection, it appeared that the violations of Title 15A NC Administrative Code .0563 Applicability Requirements for Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfills (1)(a),(1)(b), and .0566 Operational Requirements for Land Clearing Inert Debris(LCID) Landfills (2),(16), have been corrected as requested in the Notice of Violation dated April 06, 1999.



Dear Mr. Doggett

On March 18, 1999, Hugh Jernigan conducted an inspection of the notified LCID owned and operated by you on Cherry Grove Road, Caswell County, North Carolina. The inspection revealed violations of the applicability and operational criteria for Land Clearing and Inert Debris Landfills operating under notification. Specifically, the following violations of title 15A NC Administrative Code were observed at the time of the inspection:

- .0563 Applicability Requirements for Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfills
  - (1)(a) The facility is to be operated for the disposal of land clearing waste, inert debris, untreated wood, and yard trash. Operations must be consistent and in compliance with the local government solid waste management plan as approved by the Division of Solid Waste Management.
  - (1)(b) The total disposal area is under two acres in size.
  
- .0566 Operational Requirements for Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfills
  - (2) The facility shall only accept those solid wastes which it is permitted to receive.
  - (16) A sign shall be posted at the facility entrance showing the contact name and number in case of an emergency and the permit number. The permit number requirement is not applicable for facilities not requiring an individual permit.

In order to correct the violations, the following actions must be taken June 11, 1999:

- 1) All waste other than land clearing and inert debris must be removed and properly disposed of at a facility permitted to receive the waste (i.e., Alamance County Landfill, Cobles C&D Landfill). Receipts from the permitted facility must be provided to Jeff Boyd,


- 2) Remove and properly dispose of all waste that has been deposited outside of the notified two acres.
- 3) A sign shall be posted at the facility entrance showing the contact name and number in case of an emergency.
- 4) Implement erosion control measures as required, by grading and seeding in accordance with Sedimentation Pollution Control Act (15A North Carolina Administrative Code 4). You may contact the Land Quality Section of the Division of Land Resources at (336) 771-4600, if you have any questions pertaining to the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act.

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 130A-22(a) and 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B, Section .0701-.0707, an administrative penalty of up to \$5,000.00 (five thousand dollars) per day may be assessed for violations of the Solid Waste Laws or Regulations.

Please keep me informed of your progress during removal of the waste as interim inspections will be made. Upon completion of removal, a final inspection is required.
