Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 130A-22(a) and to 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B, I conducted an inspection on 24 February, 2004, of the Leslie E Parson Landfill LCID notification, located off at 2490 US Hwy 17 North, in Craven County, North Carolina.

My inspection found that the unpermissible material and the residue from the burned materials had been removed from the site and disposed of at a permitted facility. I found no further violations during this site visit. The NOV issued has been resolved.

Subject: **NOTICE OF VIOLATION**
Leslie E Parson Landfill/LCID notification
Craven County

Dear Mr Parson:

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 130A-22(a) and to 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B, I conducted an inspection on 4 November, 2003, of the Leslie E Parson Landfill LCID notification, located off at 2490 US Hwy 17 North, in Craven County, North Carolina.

My inspection found that land clearing debris, and tree waste was being piled up and burned. Also, pressure treated lumber was being mixed in with the tree waste and burned. The open burning of solid waste and the disposal of C&D waste at this facility constitutes a violation of the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules, codified at 15A NC Admin. Code 13B; specifically:


15A N.C. Admin. Code 13B .0563(1)(a) states that "The facility is to be operated for the disposal of land clearing waste, inert debris, untreated wood, and yard trash." and .0566(2) "The facility shall only accept those wastes which it is permitted to receive," and .0566(12) "Open burning of solid waste is prohibited."

You are in violation of Section 13B .0563(1)(a) and .0566(2) in that C&D waste has been disposed of in this notified LCID landfill, and .0566(12) in that solid waste has been burned in this notified landfill

Based on the foregoing, discontinue all dumping operations and by 5 December, 2003 comply with 15A NCAC 13B .0563 LCID Landfills by taking the following action:

1. Cease all burning of solid waste.
2. Coordinate the excavation of this waste with myself by calling and scheduling a time for us to coordinate the unapproved solid waste being removed.
3. Ensure that all waste is removed from the site, and transported to a Division approved solid waste disposal facility. **Provide receipts from this facility to:**



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4. Implement erosion control measures as required by grading and seeding in accordance with Sedimentation Pollution Control Act (15A NCAC 4). You may contact the Land Quality Section of the Division of Land Resources at (252)946-6481 if you have any questions pertaining to the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act.

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22(a) and 15A N.C.A.C. 13B .0701-.0707, an administrative penalty of up to \$5,000.00 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Management Laws or Regulations.
