The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received L & L Environmental Services LLC's new permit application for the proposed compost facility located in Anson County, on February 5, 2013, entitled;

L & L Environmental Services LLC is requesting a Permit to Continue to Operate our Solid Waste Composting Facility. Prepared by L & L Environmental Services LLC. February 2013. DIN19044.

The Section has performed a review of L & L Environmental Services LLC's application for a determination of completeness and determined the application is complete in accordance North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-295.8(e).
