- 1) The property is owned by Bear Garden Inc. the parcel ID is 8921 651973 and is recorded in Book 540 Page 470 of the Pasquotank Co. Register of Deeds.
- 2) This facility is approved to receive LCID waste for grounding and use as boiler fuel.
- 3) Setbacks need to be maintained as required.
- 4) Access to the site is well controlled.
- 5) The haul road was of all-weather construction.
- 6) A majority of the waste on site must be processed and removed for use within one year of acceptance.
- 7) Nonconforming waste was only in incidental amounts.
- 8) The last notification was submitted on September 4, 2013 and is current.
