The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the groundwater monitoring request located within the *First Semiannual 2013 Sampling Event* report dated July 10, 2013 (DIN 19593) and submitted on behalf of Republic Services by Herst & Associates, Inc. for the Charlotte Motor Speedway Landfill V. Republic Services is requesting that groundwater monitoring wells MW-18R and MW-18AR be monitored on an annual basis instead of a semiannual basis. These groundwater monitoring wells were installed in 2010 as part of the facility's assessment, and since their installation, no groundwater exceedances have been present in either well.

As a result, the frequency request for groundwater monitoring wells MW-18R and MW-18AR is approved as described. If groundwater monitoring results indicate any exceedances of the NC Groundwater Standards, then semiannual groundwater monitoring of the affected well(s) will be required.
