On September 16, 2013 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Duke Energy's request, entitled;

- *Request to Permit Additional Waste for Disposal, Marshall Steam Station, FGD Landfill Permit No. 1809-INDUS.* Prepared by Duke Energy. September 2013. DIN 19795.

The Request concerns Duke Energy's plan to incorporate additional wastes into the current approved list of wastes for the FGD Residue Landfill. The Request also includes changes to the Operations Plan for handling certain of the additional wastes.

The Section has reviewed the Request and hereby approves the immediate implementation of the Plan at Duke Energy's, Marshall Steam Station, FGD Residue Landfill, Permit No. 1809-INDUS-. Duke Energy shall consider the referenced Request (DIN 19795) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in this manner until the current permit is either amended or modified. Therefore, the next time the Facility prepares either a Permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit an Operations Plan which includes revised language for the additional wastes included in this Request.
