RE: Disposal Service Agreement

I recently received notice from the NC Solid Waste Section that American Refuse Systems, Inc. (ARS) applied for and received an amendment to the permit covering operation of the Siler City Transfer Station, which amends the "service area" of the Transfer Station to include Alamance, Durham, Moore, Orange, Randolph and Wake counties (see attached letter from Mr. Jim Barber).

This information comes as a surprise, since the Disposal Service Agreement between Chatham County and ARS dated May 6, 1993, specifically specifies that only wastes originating from the Counties of Lee and Chatham may be accepted at the Siler City Transfer Station. As referenced under ARTICLE I of the contract:

"County Waste Material" means all putrescible waste, including animal offal or carcasses, but excluding sewage and human waste, which definition, by way of example, but not by way of limitation, shall include refuse, garbage, trash, bulky waste and light construction and remodeling debris permitted for disposal in a Sanitary Landfill, generated by public and private enterprises and individuals in the counties of Lee and Chatham and collected in said counties. The term "County Waste Material", shall not include hazardous waste or Special Waste as defined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

As referenced under ARTICLE III, Section 3.03 of the contract:


Exclusivity. The Company shall use its best efforts not to receive any solid waste at the Transfer Station other than County Waste Material generated or deemed to be generated within the counties of Lee and Chatham by the residents and commercial and institutional establishments located within the

boundaries of said counties which has been directed to the Transfer Station pursuant to the waste flow orders of the Governmental Body with jurisdiction over waste flow during the term of this Agreement. The Company shall be entitled to rely on waste origin documents supplied by solid waste collectors upon making deliveries to the Transfer Station in satisfying its best efforts obligation to exclude Hazardous Waste, or solid waste other than County Waste Material generated or deemed to be generated in the said counties.

Considering the above, I wonder what are your intentions? How does ARS propose to utilize the Siler City Transfer Station? Is ARS willing to apply to the NC State Solid Waste Section for additional permit amendments to reflect a service area consistent with the Disposal Service Agreement referenced above?

Please let me know your intentions. Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.



CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

OPERATION:

1. This facility is permitted to receive solid waste as defined in 15A NCAC 13B .0101 (36), except that hazardous and liquid wastes are prohibited from acceptance at this facility.
2. This facility may receive solid waste that is generated within the service area described in Appendix I of this document and shall dispose of said solid waste at the Piedmont Landfill, Kernersville, Forsyth County, North Carolina.
3. This permit shall be reviewed every five (5) years. Modifications shall be in accordance with the Rules in effect at the time of review.
4. This permit is for operation of the transfer facility in accordance with the approved plans. Any revisions or modifications to these plans shall be approved by the North Carolina Solid Waste Section.
5. Operation of the facility shall occur in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0402, "Operational Requirements for Transfer Facilities", the approved operations plan prepared by Marlowe, Dreitzler & Associates and these additional requirements:
 - a. This facility shall be operated in a manner which is consistent with the State solid waste management plan and with the solid waste management plans that have been adopted by those units of local government served by the facility and approved by the Division.
 - b. On or before 1 August (or at an earlier date as requested by the Division), the owner or operator shall report to the NC Solid Waste Section, for the previous year beginning 1 July and ending 30 June, the amount by weight of the solid waste that was received at the facility and disposed of in a landfill, incinerated, or converted to fuel. To the maximum extent practicable, such reports shall indicate by weight the COUNTY of origin of all solid waste. The owner or operator shall transmit a copy of the report to the county in which the facility is located and to each county in which waste originated.

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

OPERATIONS:

- 5c. Waste shall not be stored on the "tipping floor" after operating hours. Waste can be stored in transfer trailers, in the facility with covers in place, after operating hours, but no longer than 48 hours.
- 5d. The "tipping floor" and "transfer trailer loading area" shall be maintained in a sanitary, clean condition after operating hours in accordance with the approved Operational Plan.



The purpose of this correspondence is to inform ~~Alamance~~ ^{WAKE.} County; for local planning requirements, as required in G.S. 130A -309.04, that the Solid Waste Section has received a permit amendment for the above referenced Transfer Station owned and operated by American Refuse Systems, Inc., located off of Wastewater Treatment Plant Road; Siler City, North Carolina.
