

I am writing this letter to confirm a conversation that took place between Ms. Sherry Coghill and myself earlier today.


I called Ms. Coghill in regards to the permit condition number three listed in both of the above referenced permits. The above referenced permits have been issued to American Refuse Service (ARS). Condition number three requires a review of the transfer station permit every five years. I inquired as to whether or not any action was required by ARS regarding condition number three. She indicated that a review is not required by ARS and that we could continue to operate the transfer stations in accordance with the permits specified above.

In condition number two of the above referenced permits they indicate that the waste from the transfer stations will be hauled only to the Piedmont Landfill in Kernersville, N.C. I would like to request an alternate facility for disposal, in addition to the Piedmont LF. That facility is the Uwharrie Environmental Landfill in Troy, N.C. which is located in Montgomery County. The Uwharrie Landfill is a Subtitle D approved facility.

If I have misunderstood any part of our conversation please notify me immediately. In addition please amend the permits to include waste disposal at the Uwharrie Landfill.
