Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. This was a partial inspection, requested by the county, to discuss waste placement, haul road location, and soil cover at the site.
2. The hours of operation are Mon-Fri: 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM and Sat: 8:00 – 12:00 PM.
3. The site is secured with a gate at the entrance; controlled access for safety.
4. The entrance and haul roads are being maintained so as to provide all-weather access.
5. The working face is maintained at less than one acre in size.
6. Erosion control measures placed on the north and west slope appear to be effective.
7. There was an area of ponded stormwater on the perimeter road adjacent to the toe of the north slope. It is recommended to level that area, so as to prevent a back-up of ponded water onto the cover soil.
