Please find enclosed the Permit to Construct and Operate for the Craven Ag Services Compost Facility, Permit No. 1906-COMPOST. Before the site may begin operation as the new facility, the site must meet the pre-operational conditions of the permit on pages 4 and 5, and receive approval from the Solid Waste Section.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate requirements which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations. Please review the conditions of the permit carefully.
