**Additional Comments:**

A compliance inspection was conducted of the Concrete and Yard Waste Recycling areas.

**Yard Waste Area**

1. Clean, source separated wood and yard waste is currently stockpiled to be ground into mulch.
2. Some of the yard waste is currently being disposed of in the C&DLF due to the lack of funding.
3. Yard trash is being composted in accordance to the Type I composting facility requirements.

**Concrete Stockpile/Crushing Area**

4. The concrete stockpile area continues to grow as grinding is not occurring in accordance to the approved operations plan that was submitted in October of 2005.
5. The approved operations plan for the recycling area over the closed LCID submitted to the Division on October 31, 2005 states that “Concrete crushing operations will only be performed when an adequate stock pile of materials are present. Approximately five crushing operations will be performed per year, if materials exist”.
6. The facility informed me that they had received some funding to resume crushing/grinding operations. The funding is necessary to reduce the large stockpile.
7. The facility was being well managed at the time of this inspection; however, it may be necessary to re-evaluate the operations plan in the future if the site cannot be operated in accordance with the approved plan for grinding/crushing.
