Dear Ms. McQueen:

On June 25, 2013, the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received an application for a 5-yr permit amendment for the Currituck County Transfer State (DIN 19226). A technical review of the application has been conducted. Please address the following comments and questions concerning the application. Modify the application where appropriate.

1. Please provide contact information for Republic Services. Although Bowen Company, Inc. employees may operate the facility, the application indicates that the contractual agreement is between the Currituck County and Republic Services. If this is not correct, please clarify.
2. Assuming the above is correct, a Certification by Operator page is needed from Republic Services. Please make sure the blanks are filled in correctly. The form signed by Bowen Company, Inc. did not include the name of the facility which they certified they have an agreement to operate.
3. The name of the division is currently the Division of Waste Management.
4. Please provide a site layout showing the transfer station and identify the areas described in the application. This can be done by obtaining a photo of the facility from the county's GIS and putting labels on the photo. I have included an example to help understand what I am requesting.
5. Do you have an estimate of the size of the transfer facility (acres)? The property is quite large and has an old landfill, airport, LCID, etc. It would also be helpful to have a drawing of the property with the approximate location of the transfer station. Again, this

can be a parcel drawing from your GIS with the transfer station location shown and I have included an example.

6. Dare and Camden Counties will be added to service area based on Section II B in the operation plan.
7. A Fire Occurrence Report was developed by the Section for use in reporting fires. It is available online at <http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wm/sw/forms>. You may want to download the form and place it in your operation plan.
8. The Section is now requesting that all solid waste facility permits be recorded with the county's Register of Deeds. I could not find a record of the transfer station permit being recorded. Therefore, I will send a certified copy with recordation instructions with the next permit. If I am in error on this, please let me know the book and page numbers of the recordation.


