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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

1. 500 TPD are expected to be transported to the facility.
2. The operating hours are from 6am to 5pm M/F and 6am to 1pm on Saturday.
3. The certified operators are: Raymond M. Norris expires 12/6/16 , Kim Dalgo expires 10/9/2016, Jeremy Willis expires 10/9/2016.
4. The waste stream consists of construction and demolition waste yard debris, single stream recyclables and dry recyclable waste. Recyclables other than C&D will be deposited on the floor in a separate area and loaded into open top trailers for transport to the Hampton Material Recovery Facility. C&D will be deposited on the tipping floor in a designated area loaded into open top trailers and hauled to the Hampton Roads Recovery Center. Incoming loads will be inspected by the driver, facility operator and equipment operators to minimize chance of unapproved materials being accepted.
5. The service area is Camden, Currituck, Dare, Pasquotank, and Perquimans Counties.
6. Waste will be transported to the Centerville Turnpike CDD Landfill, Virginia Beach Va. (Virginia Permit Number SWP 603.)
7. The financial assurance was submitted on July 8, 2013 with the closure estimate of \$30,000.
8. A DWQ storm water permit is apparently not required at this facility.
9. A camera is mounted above the scales so loads can be inspected prior to dumping in the facility.
10. The facility is very clean.
