General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may also be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. The site is a permitted LCID Landfill under construction (Permit No. 29-09-LCID-2013). The site was evaluated and approved for use as a Temporary Disaster Debris Site.
2. The Temporary Disaster Debris Site, DS 29-006 was activated on 4/21/14 for vegetative debris storage and processing as a result of the March 6-7, 2014 storm event. No disposal of vegetative waste collected from the storm event is approved at the site.
3. The site is utilized by DRC (contracted by the Department of Transportation) for storage and processing of storm debris collected from the northern areas of Davidson County. Temporary scales were installed for documentation of incoming storm debris.
4. The collection of storm debris for the northern areas of Davidson County has been completed. Approximately 2,200 tons or 11,000 cubic yards of debris has been received at this site (unverified).
5. The site has approval for open burning of the collected vegetative waste as per approval letter (including operational requirements for open burning) from the Division of Air Quality, dated May 1, 2014.
6. Activities at the site observed to be in accordance with Temporary Disaster Debris Site requirements.
7. Upon completion of Disaster Debris operations a closure/deactivation inspection will be conducted at the site
