Dear Mr. Long:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Operate for the Durham Compost Facility, Permit No. 3204-COMPOST-1991. This permit issuance increases the site capacity to 18,000 tons per year, with a 3% increase per year for subsequent years, and corrects an error in the date listed in condition 1 on page 4 of the June 20, 2014 permit. The modification is an addendum to the 2010 approved permit application. The permit expires June 9, 2015.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate requirements which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations. Please review the conditions of the permit carefully.

With the permit review, the Section concurs with the City's proposal to no longer maintain the fence around the retention pond. The Section agrees that the City should maintain the integrity of the pond liner at the level of the pond freeboard and below (not above), and that damages to the pond liner at this level and below should be immediately repaired. The Section also agrees to the proposed change in pond level to a maximum of 302.3 on the monitoring gauge.
