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Hey Sam:

The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the Operation Plan (Doc ID 20846) for the above-referenced Transfer Station and a few comments stated below:

1. Please have Mr. Cummings to complete the attached certification form – Signature Page of Applicant, which is a part of the permit application.
2. (Section 3 & Appendix II) Since the wastewater permit is required to be renewed either annually or a time-frame much less than the request 10-year permit cycle, the wastewater permit(s), either historical or current ones must be placed in the operating records and subjected to periodic inspection and review by the Solid Waste Section. Please add the requirement to this Section.
3. (Section 4.2 & Section 6 of Appendix IV) Please reference and append the SWS “Fire Occurrence Report” (see attached document) to the Operations Plan. Should a fire occurs, the form can be used to report a fire incident. 4. (Appendix IV) Please verify and confirm the phone number of NC Division Emergency Management. The phone numbers to reach Ben Barnes have been changed to 252-236-4453 (office) & 919-621-3680 (mobile).
