The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Extension Request - Groundwater Corrective Action Plan* (DIN 20356) dated January 7, 2014 and submitted by ERM NC, Inc. on behalf of R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company for the Rural Hall Ash Landfill, Solid Waste Permit Number 34-05.

Within the *Extension Request - Groundwater Corrective Action Plan* letter, R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company is requesting a 30 day extension for the submittal of Corrective Action Plan. The Solid Waste Section approved R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company's selected remedy for the Rural Hall Ash Landfill on October 10, 2013. Within that letter, the Solid Waste Section requested a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to be submitted within 90 days.
