OmniSource Southeast LLC - Kernersville Plant is listed as the Permit Owner and Operator of the Solid Waste Management Facility, Permit No. 3420-INDUS-2005. Now that the Notice of Violation, dated September 2, 2011 has been resolved (DIN 19169), the Solid Waste Section requires that your expired Permit be renewed.

Solid Waste Permits are valid for five (5) years and the renewal of an existing Solid Waste Permit must be requested and accompanied by a complete application submitted in accordance with North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-294 and must meet the requirements of North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B. A Permitting Fee will be required under North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A-295.8.
