On March 17, 2014 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Abbey Green's request, entitled;  
*Abbey Green, Inc., request to receive "directional subsurface drill cuttings" into the Solid Waste Management Facility, Permit No. 3424.* Prepared by Abbey Green, Inc. March 2014. DIN 20739.

The Request concerns Abbey Green's desire to accept, de-water and utilize "directional subsurface drill cuttings" at its facility, Permit No. 3424-TRANSFER-2010.

The Section has reviewed the Request and hereby approves Abbey Green's plan to utilize the "directional subsurface drill cuttings" at the facility. Abbey Green shall consider the referenced Request (DIN 20739) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in this manner until the current permit is either amended or modified. Therefore, the next time the Facility prepares either a Permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit an Operations Plan which includes revised language for the utilization of "directional subsurface drill cuttings".
