On February 28, 2014 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Duke Energy's Plan, entitled;  
*Allen Steam Station, Retired Ash Basin (RAB) Ash Landfill (Permit No. 3612), Corrective Action Response Plan. Prepared by S&ME. Prepared for Duke Energy. February 2014. DIN 20678.*

The Section has reviewed the Plan and hereby approves the immediate implementation of the Plan at Duke Energy's, Allen Steam Station, Retired Ash Basin (RAB) Landfill Facility, Permit No. 3612-INDUS-2008. Duke Energy shall consider the Plan (DIN 20678) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in this manner until the current permit is either amended or modified. Therefore, the next time the Facility prepares either a Permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit an Operations Plan which includes revised language regarding Cell 1's improved erosion and sedimentation control measures. Also, the Section requests Duke Energy provide as-built drawings of Cell 1 with the approved configuration.
