The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Corrective Action Plan* dated May 2014 (DIN 21280), received on May 23, 2014, and submitted on behalf of Granville County by Joyce Engineering for the Closed Granville County Butner MSW Landfill. The *Corrective Action Plan* was submitted in response to the consistent groundwater exceedances at the facility.

In accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .1635-.1636 and 15A NCAC 2L, Granville County selected a remedy to restore groundwater quality at and beyond the relevant point of compliance, to effectively reduce the overall groundwater contamination at the facility, and to control the migration of contaminated groundwater to prevent unacceptable impacts. The Solid Waste Section approved the County's selected remedy of Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA) and Phytoremediation on October 30, 2013 (DIN 20041).

As a result, the *Corrective Action Plan* is approved as described for immediate implementation.
