The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Monitoring Well Replacement* letter dated July 12, 2013 (DIN 19400) and submitted by S&ME, Inc. on behalf of the City of Greensboro for the White Street Landfill. The City of Greensboro is requesting to replace compliance groundwater monitoring well II-4 associated with Phase II. This groundwater monitoring well has indicated very high turbidity levels for a number of years. Due to these consistent levels, the City of Greensboro is proposing to install a replacement groundwater monitoring well approximately 10 feet away utilizing a 15 foot well screen. Following the installation, the new groundwater monitoring well will be developed and a slug test will be conducted.
