Dear Mr. Marcum:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section), hereby grants approval to Waste Industries High Point Landfill, LLC to begin operations in the High Point C&D Debris Landfill (Permit 41-16) recently constructed Phase 2B-1.

Smith Gardner provided the Construction Quality Assurance report for Phase 2B-1 on June 18, 2014 (DIN 21326). The report described the construction of the new phase and contained the information required by the Permit to Construct conditions including a subgrade inspection report, piezometer abandonment records, photos of the construction, as-built survey, and revised financial assurance estimate.

Mr. Hugh Jernigan of the Section visited the landfill on June 26 and noted that edge-of-waste markers were installed and the proper erosion control measures had been constructed. This is also in accordance with the Permit to Construct.

The financial assurance estimate was approved (DIN 21327) and Ms. Sarah Rice has indicated that the financial instruments are in place reflecting the approved amounts.

You have submitted the information required under the permit, however, the Section staff require additional time to complete the review and to prepare and issue the Permit to Operate. This approval allows you to receive waste in the new phase under the terms and condition of the current Permit to Operate until the Section can issue the new Permit to Operate.
