Please find the enclosed Permit to Construct and Operate for the WI Burnt Poplar Transfer, LLC, Permit No.41-22T, which approves modified construction and operation on to the facility. Operation of the new facilities for use in transferring municipal solid waste and for processing and collecting recyclables, is contingent on fulfilling the conditions noted in Attachment 2 (Conditions of the Permit to Construct), Part VI, Item 7. The new operations must not be conducted prior to approval by the Section representative.

In general, the facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans. Please review the conditions of the permit thoroughly.
