I am writing this email in regard to your request regarding the acceptance of dead animal waste that is comingled with MSW waste from the Halifax County Transfer Station.

In accordance with State regulations and the conditions of the permit for the East Carolina Environmental Landfill, animal waste that is delivered to the site must be covered immediately.

As a result, all waste loads coming from your transfer station that are mixed with a small quantity of animal waste will be accepted on the condition that you notify the facility via telephone prior to the load leaving the transfer station and upon entering the landfill facility. If any special instructions are required regarding the mixed load, they will be relayed to the driver at the scale house.

Large loads of animal waste should not be mixed at the transfer station and should be hauled directly to the landfill for disposal. Again, you should notify the facility via telephone as soon as the delivery truck is en route to the landfill facility.
