The Division of Waste Management (DWM), Solid Waste Section (SWS) received the following documents regarding the activities of removing the portions of the existing French drain located along the north and northeast sides of the active C&DLF – Phase II. The documents are titled:

- *French Drain Removal Update – C&D Landfill (Permit No. 43-03), Harnett County Anderson Creek Landfill Facility.* Prepared by Smith Gardner, Inc. June 26, 2014 (DIN 21343).
