Dear Ms. Bader:

The Division of Waste Management (DWM), Solid Waste Section (SWS) has received the following documents related to the Project 2 – Convenience Center and Transfer Station Improvement Projects (Doc ID 17302) and the Transfer Station Design Revision (Doc ID 19952), which are prepared on your behalf by C. Tyrus Clayton, Jr., PE. The documents are:

- Construction Site Visit Reports from March 15, 2013 through August 16, 2013, received by the SWS on September 16, 2013 (Doc ID 19806).
- Construction Site Visit Reports from August 20, 2013 through October 07, 2013, received by the SWS on October 11, 2013 (Doc ID 19989).
- Transfer Station As-Built Certification (Certification Report) dated January 24, 2014 including as-built drawings and construction site visit reports from October 08, 2013 through December 20, 2013 (Doc ID 20454).

After reviewing above-mentioned reports and as-built drawings, the SWS determines that the Dunn-Erwin Solid Waste Transfer Facility (Permit No. 43-07T) has satisfied the permit conditions stipulated in Attachment 2 – Conditions of Permit To Construct (PTC) dated March 28, 2013 (Doc ID 18605). According to the Permit Condition No. 8 of the PTC, Dunn-Erwin Solid Waste Transfer Facility can utilize and operate the transfer station according to permit conditions stipulated in Attachment 3 – Conditions of Permit To Operate (PTO) dated March 28, 2013 (Doc ID 18605). This approval doesn't change the PTO expiration dated which will expire on **March**

28, 2018. Please place the approval documents including this approval letter to the facility operating record.

According to As-Built Drawing SHEET 2.2.1, the two underground holding tanks that were used to collect leachate/wash-down liquid were not removed, but were disconnected from the new drainlines, and left in-place in the course of the Rehab Project.
