Dear Ms. Bader:

Please be advised that Permit to Operate for Anderson Creek Transfer Station under the Solid Waste Permit No. 43-09T expired on **February 27, 2012**. Harnett County (the County), the owner and operator of the above-referenced facility must take one of the following actions:

- (1) Cease the waste operations and close the facility or
- (2) Submit the Division of Waste Management (DWM), Solid Waste Section (SWS) a permit renewal application for review and approval to continue operation and pay the statutory required fee. Renewal of the existing Solid Waste Permit must be requested and accompanied by a completed application submitted in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 130A-294 and must meet the requirements of North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B.

No later than **September 27, 2013**, the County shall inform the SWS the decision and submit the written closure notification or the completed permit application.
