I have reviewed the application submitted for the five-year permit amendment for continued operation of the Hertford County Transfer Station. The application was received by the NCDENR Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section on December 11, 2013 (DIN 20269). I have the following questions and comments.

1. Is the transfer station in Winton or Ahoskie? The physical address is listed as Ahoskie, but everywhere else it is listed as being in Winton.
