The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of Jackson County's *Plan for Spraying Kudzu at Landfill* dated May 1, 2014 (DIN 20945) for the Closed Jackson County Landfill, Solid Waste Section Permit Number 50-02. The County is requesting to utilize a herbicide, Streamline by Dupont, to be sprayed by a local licensed herbicide sprayer, on the invasive kudzu located on the landfill in an area approximately 4.5 acres. The first application is scheduled to be applied in June 2014, and hydroseeding will follow. Additional treatments of the herbicide may be required.
