Mr. Parker:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed the review of the document titled *Operations Plan Scott Creek Transfer Station*, revised October 24, 2013 (DIN 20225). The Plan was revised to allow for the recycling of empty pesticide containers. The document was submitted via email and was received in the Asheville Regional Office on October 24, 2013.

Based on this review, the Section authorizes the recycling of pesticide containers as detailed in the revised Operations Plan. The revised Operations Plan is now part of the approved plan for the facility and must be maintained on site. There are no permit conditions associated with this activity, so no permit modification will be required and no permit fee assessed. As a result, the revised Operations Plan will not be listed in the Permit to Operate until the next permitting activity. Any significant changes to the submitted plan will require approval by the Section prior to implementation.
