

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section has reviewed the City of Sanford's request to modify its existing Type III Compost Facility by using the over flow area for windrows. It appears your request can be approved pending the following:

- 1) The orientation of the windrows should be shown on the site plan. Windrows should be laid out in such a manner that water will not collect at the base of the windrows.
- 2) The engineers seal on the site plan appears to be dated 1992. An up to date seal needs to be on the application.
- 3) Four copies of the revised application must be submitted.

Permit Conditions

1. Operation and maintenance of this facility shall be in accordance with the Solid Waste Compost Rules(15A NCAC 13B, Section .1400), the permit application and the Operation and Maintenance Manual submitted with the permit application. Failure to comply may result in compliance actions or permit revocation.
2. This facility shall be operated in such a manner that erosion and runoff from the site shall be controlled. Any leachate generated at the facility shall be managed in such a manner that it will not be not allowed to adversely affect ground or surface waters.
3. Only materials specifically listed in the permit application may be managed at this facility without adequate testing and prior approval of the Division of Waste Management.
4. Active composting of manures or materials other than yard waste shall not occur within the 500 foot setback of residences to the east of the facility.
5. All compost produced at the facility shall meet the requirements of Rule .1407 of the Solid Waste Compost Rules and the permit application.
6. **Compost shall not be distributed prior to approval by the Division of Waste Management in accordance with .1407(e) of the Municipal Solid Waste Compost Facility Rules.**
7. Testing and reporting shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of Rule .1408 and the permit application. An annual report of facility activities for the fiscal year July 1 to June 30 shall be submitted to the Division by August 1 of each year. This report shall include the amount of materials composted in tons.
8. Groundwater monitoring wells may be required if there is indication of the potential for groundwater contamination.
9. The compost operation and the compost pad shall be operated and maintained with sufficient dust control measures to minimize airborne emissions and to prevent dust from becoming a nuisance or safety hazard.
10. This permit shall expire on March 1, 2003. Changes in ownership, increase in facility capacity, or receiving additional feedstocks shall require a permit modification.
