CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

OPERATION:

1. This facility is permitted to receive solid waste as defined in G.S. 130A - 290(35), except that hazardous and liquid wastes are prohibited from acceptance at this facility.
2. This facility may receive solid waste that is generated within the service area described in Appendix I of this document and shall dispose of said solid waste at the Sampson County Disposal landfill (permit #82-02, primary location) in Roseboro, Sampson County, North Carolina and the Uwharrie Environmental Landfill (permit #62-04) in Troy, Montgomery County, North Carolina as the secondary site.
3. This permit shall be reviewed every five (5) years, on/or before 10 December 2009. Modifications shall be in accordance with the Rules in effect at the time of review.
4. This permit is for operation of the transfer facility in accordance with the approved plans, the Operational Plan dated 23 July 1993 prepared by Marlowe, Drietzler approved 10 August 1993. Any revisions or modifications to these plans shall be approved by the North Carolina Solid Waste Section.
5. Operation of the facility shall occur in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0402, "Operational Requirements for Transfer Facilities", the approved operational plans listed in condition five above and these additional requirements:
 - a. The owner or operator of a municipal solid waste management facility shall not knowingly dispose of any type or form of municipal solid waste that is generated within the boundaries of a unit of local government that by ordinance:
 1. Prohibits generators or collectors of municipal solid waste from disposing of that type or form of municipal solid waste.
 2. Requires generators or collectors of municipal solid waste to recycle that type or form municipal solid waste.

OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS CONTINUED:

- b. On or before 1 August(or at an earlier date as requested by the Division), the owner or operator shall report to the NC Solid Waste Section, for the previous year beginning 1 July and ending 30 June, the amount by weight of the solid waste that was received at the facility and disposed of in a landfill, incinerated, or converted to fuel. To the maximum extent practicable, such reports shall indicate by weight the COUNTY of origin of all solid waste. The owner or operator shall transmit a copy of the report to the county in which the facility is located and to each county in which waste originated.
- c. Waste shall not be stored on the "tipping floor" after operating hours. Waste can be stored in transfer trailers, at the facility with covers in place, after operating hours, but no longer than 48 hours.
- d. The transfer facility shall be maintained in a sanitary, clean condition after operating hours in accordance with the Operational Plan dated 23 July 1993 prepared by Marlowe, Drietzler & Assoc. approved 10 August 1993.

5. AMENDMENT #1(7 July 1999): Letter dated 26 June 1998 from Mike Loyd, EH&S Regional Director for Waste Management, requesting the renewal of permit #53-04T and requesting that the Uwharrie Environmental Landfill be an alternate disposal facility for the referenced transfer station.
6. AMENDMENT #2(17 Feb. 2000): Letter and shop drawings dated 12 Jan. 2000, addressing proposed upgrades to the transfer station consisting of leachate collection system, approach apron, curb and gutter replacement and retaining wall modification.
7. AMENDMENT #3(7 December 2004): Letter dated 6 October 2004, addressing proposed revisions to the transfer station consisting adding Johnston, Cumberland and Sampson counties to the service area for the transfer station. Also, adding Sampson County Disposal in Roseboro, NC as the primary disposal site.
8. AMENDMENT #4(10 December 2004): Letter dated 6 October 2004 from Mike Loyd, Division Engineer for Waste Management, requesting the renewal of permit #53-04T and requesting that the Sampson County Disposal be designated the primary disposal site and Uwharrie Environmental Landfill be an alternate disposal facility for the referenced transfer station. Also, the letter requested that Cumberland, Johnston and Sampson counties be added to the service area of the transfer station.
