Please find the enclosed Permit to Construct and Operate for the Sanford Transfer Station, Permit No. 5305-TRANSFER-2013, which approves construction and operation of the facility, contingent on fulfilling the conditions noted Attachment 2 (Conditions of the Permit to Construct), Part VI, Item 7.

In general, the facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans. Please review the conditions of the permit thoroughly.

Also included is a certified original of the permit. The certified original is provided for recordation with the Lee County Register of Deeds. A copy of the certified original affixed with the Register's seal and the date, book, and page numbers of the recording must be returned within 30 calendar days of issue to the Permitting Branch Supervisor as noted at the bottom of the certification statement.

Waste may not be accepted before a representative of the Section has notified the Permitting Branch Supervisor in writing that the conditions in Attachment 2, Part VI, Item 7 have been met. It is your responsibility to contact the Section to set up the inspection.
