Deep Run Transfer Station, Lenoir County, North Carolina,  
Permit No. 54-08T, Document ID No. (Doc ID) 20614

Dear Mr. Pflieger:

The Division of Waste Management (DWM), Solid Waste Section (SWS) has completed a review of the permit amendment application which is titled:

- *Operations Manual. Deep Run Transfer Station.* Prepared by Waste Industries, LLC. January 13, 2014, received by SWS January 17, 2014, and revised through February 10, 2014. (Doc ID 20615).

Waste Industries LLC leased the transfer station property from Al Hill Properties, LLC, the property owner in 2013 and submitted the above-referenced permit application to request the SWS to approve:

1. Transferring the Solid Waste Management Permit Number 5408T-Transfer-2001 held by Onslow Container Service, Inc. to Waste Industries LLC.
2. Changing the facility name from Onslow Container Service Transfer Station to Deep Run Transfer Station.
3. Increasing and changing service areas that permitted wastes are generated and received at the transfer station.
4. Changing the waste disposal facilities.

Based on the review of permit application, the SWS approves the requests and hereby issues Waste Industries, LLC the Permit to Operate (Doc ID 20613) to operate Deep Run Transfer Station under the Solid Waste Management Permit Number 5408-TRANSFER-2014. Waste Industries, LLC shall operate the waste transfer facility in accordance with the approved Operations Manual and all applicable local, state, and federal rules. This Permit to Operate shall expire **February 21, 2019**.

Additionally, please pay special attention to the General Permit Condition No. 3 of Attachment 1 of the permit regarding permit recordation requirement. The certified copy of the permit (enclosed) must be filed in the Register of Deeds office in Lenoir County, and the copy (entire document including permit) is returned to the SWS, within thirty (30) calendar days, from the date received, with the page and book number, date of recordation, and Register's seal.

Enclosed please find a hard copy of Permit to Operate for the above-referenced transfer station and the approved Operations Manual. The electronic format of the approved documents can be directly downloaded from the DWM's web site at <https://edm.nc.gov/DENR-Portal/>. Type in the Doc ID Number (only numeric number) in the boxed area next to the "**Description**" in the "**Property Criteria**" area. Then click "**Search**" box. The document in "pdf" format will appear on the lower section of the screen called "**Content**" area.
