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
OBSEVED VIOLATIONS:

No violations observed.

Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the general Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and rules.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

1. Observed facility has proper security gate and required signage posted at entrance.
2. Observed responsible attendant on duty.
3. Facility is permitted for Land Clearing and Inert Debris Treatment and Processing. Facility may receive land clearing waste as defined in 15A NCAC 13B, Rule .0101 (23), unpainted and untreated natural wood, and wooden pallets constructed of untreated and unpainted natural wood. Observed that facility is receiving land clearing debris, yard waste, stumps, limbs and untreated wood.
4. Observed volume of material has not exceeded maximum permitted 100,000 cubic yards.
5. No unapproved waste was observed on site.
6. Observed mulch piles and rows were well maintained and organized, with adequate access and fire breaks.
7. No nuisance conditions (fugitive dust emissions, vector problems or windblown materials) were observed.
8. Observed effective surface water and erosion control management at facility.
9. Observed copy of permit available on site.
10. Advised on requirements to submit annual report to Solid Waste Section.
