The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Seep Response Summary and Sampling Plan* dated December 23, 2013 (DIN 20337) and submitted by Smith Garner, Inc. for the Red Rock C&D Landfill. The *Seep Response Summary and Sampling Plan* was submitted in response to the Notice of Violation issued on December 5, 2013. Within the Notice of Violation, Waste Industries, Inc. was required to submit a sampling plan for review and approval to the Solid Waste Section.

The submitted *Seep Response Summary and Sampling Plan* includes subsurface soil sampling at specific locations. Two subsurface soil samples and one background subsurface soil sample will be collected. The subsurface soil samples will be analyzed for Appendix I of 40 CFR 258 (Volatile Organic Compounds and Metals) and pH. The results of the soil sampling event will then be submitted to the Solid Waste Section.

As a result, the *Seep Response Summary and Sampling Plan* is approved as described. Please implement the approved plan within seven days of receipt of this letter, and please also submit the results of the soil sampling event within 30 days of receiving the analytical results from the laboratory. Based upon the initial sampling results, additional activities may be required.
