Please find enclosed the Permit to Operate for the East Wake Transfer Station, Permit No. 9233T-TRANSFER. This permit issuance approves the 5 year permit renewal. The issuance also approves an addendum to the operating plan, which addresses previous problems with leaking trailers.

The permit expires February 17, 2019. An application for permit renewal should be submitted six months prior to the expiration.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations. Please review the conditions of the permit carefully.
