Dear Ms. Cahoon:

On January 10, 2014 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Domtar's Request, entitled;

*Proposed Revisions to Domtar Operations Plan Phases 2, 3, and 4 last revised October 2012.*  
Prepared by Domtar. January 2014. DIN 20247.

The Request concerns revisions to the Domtar approved Operations Plan.

The Section has reviewed the Request and hereby approves the immediate implementation of the revisions at the Domtar Paper Company Landfill. However, the Section considers the segregating and/or mixing of materials within 4 feet of the liner as the barest of safety minimums, for protection of the liner. The Section's suggests Domtar maximize the distance of activity to liner, if possible.

Domtar shall consider the referenced Request (DIN 20247) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in this manner until the current permit is either amended or modified. Therefore, the next time the Facility prepares either a Permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit an Operations Plan which includes revised language referenced in this Approval.
