SUMMARY OF COMMUNICATION

I received a request for a meeting about the landfill from Grady Hassell. Grady is in charge of the Washington County Water Department and has had the landfill placed under his department now that Allen Davenport is so sick—in fact, I found out that Allen had passed away on the 27 TH when I arrived at the landfill for my meeting with Grady.

The following are the issues we talked about:


Disposal space – The site was permitted as a C&D/scrap tire monofill ( see Drawing ). They have used up all the space in the C&D area due to the hurricane but have space in the tire part because they are disposing of their tires with Thomas Womble . They would like to use that space to dispose of what is coming in now. The permit to operate was issued on April 30, 2001 so it has not expired. We tried to call Jim Barber but he was in a meeting. It is my understanding that Washington County sent in a request for this but perhaps did not have all the information and/or did not present their request clearly.

Future disposal space=== We were told that Alan Keith with the firm of Deal and Phillips came by the landfill sometime around Christmas and picked up the plans. When we called him, he was not able to tell us much but did promise to call Grady by the end of the week. The County had a man lined up to extend the berms of the C&D but I told them they did not need to be constructing anything with out a permit to construct.

Certified operator== with Allen gone, they do not have a certified operator. They are planning to run an ad for the position right away but I am sure they will not be able to hire a trained operator. The only other person that currently works at the landfill is an older retired man who works part time (Fred). I told them I would work with them as much as I could but they would need to get someone certified right away

Equipment—they only had one small dozer with a multipurpose blade—it is worn out and now broken down- they have a rental on site now, I believe Grady said they were planning on buying it. He also said on slack days he could put some of the water department equipment in the landfill.

- Other issues—discussed
- weekly cover and seeding for C&D
  - Monthly cover on LCID Notification
  - Storm drbris- processed and removed within 6 mo.
  - Closed MSW requirements and audit
