Dear Mr. Davis :

On August 26, 2013, Ben Barnes, representing the State of North Carolina, Division of Waste Management Solid Waste Section, inspected the above referenced facility for compliance with North Carolina Solid Waste Statues and Rules. Andy Davis was present representing Wilson County Westside Construction and Demolition Debris Landfill. During this inspection, the following items were noted and/or observed:

A. 15A NCAC 13B 0544 (e) A waste acceptability program. Owners and operators of all C&DLF units must implement a program at the facility for detecting and preventing the disposal of industrial, hazardous, liquid, municipal solid waste and excluded wastes in accordance with the Operating Plan or the effective permit. This program must include, at a minimum: (1) random inspections of incoming loads or other comparable procedures.

The above deficiencies can compromise the facility's ability to ensure protection of the public health and the environment and thus require remedial action on behalf of the facility in order to achieve compliance with 15A NCAC 13B .0563 (2)(c). **By August 26, 2013, the facility must complete the following:**

In order to be brought into compliance, initiate a program of regular waste screening in which at least 1 percent of the incoming waste is screened maintain records the results of these inspections.

Failure to comply with this schedule may subject the facility and/or all responsible parties to enforcement actions including a notice of violation, civil penalty, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.
