Dear Ms. MacQueen:

I am writing to advise you of the status of the referenced application. The Solid Waste Section acknowledges the receipt of an administratively complete application, but there are concerns about the waste types proposed for disposal, specifically coal ash. As we discussed on August 9, 1993, coal ash is not included in the definition of land clearing and inert debris (LCID), therefore cannot be disposed in LCID landfills.

However, there are rules pending that may guide you in evaluating your management options for this material. On September 15, 1993, proposed rules will be published in the North Carolina Register regarding the management of coal ash. The public comment period will extend for 30 days after that date. We encourage everyone with an interest in this topic to offer comments on these proposed rules.
