1. This site was conditionally approved and activated to handle storm debris generated from the winter ice storm.
2. The purpose of this inspection was to view the processing area, waste types, and site management.
3. All waste staged was vegetative debris.
4. The site appears to have stopped receiving waste, as the entrance was cabled and the sign has been removed. There is a pile of ground waste located on the site. As a reminder, all of the debris brought to the site from the storm needs to be removed before the expiration of the activation, which is August 19, 2014.
